# **Staff Development Questions**

- What do our teachers believe about our student's ability to read and write?
  - Do our teachers know the reading levels of students in the classroom?
  - Are staff able to look at a reading and accurately determine which students will be able to decode enough of the reading to understand the content?
- What do our teachers know about reading and writing?
  - Are staff able to identify if students are unable to process reading because of decoding or comprehension issues?
  - What do staff know about the writing process and how to provide feedback on student writing?
- What reading and writing practices currently exist and who is doing them?
  - In which class are students producing the highest quality writing? Why?
  - Where are there currently opportunitities for students to practice decoding, fluency, and comprehension in content courses?
